

How to acquire Salvation!

Jesus came to the earth to restore unto man—all that satan has stolen from him; to remove from man everything satan has planted in him.

In return to restore and recover man from everything satan has stripped him off.

The Salvation Plan:

How to accept Jesus Christ as your personal Saviour.

First Step: COME !!!

Isa 1:18 Come now, and let us reason together, saith the LORD: though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they be red like crimson, they shall be as wool.

Mat 11:28 Come unto Me [Jesus], all [ye] that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.

Joh 6:37 All that the Father giveth Me shall come to Me; and him that cometh to Me I will in no wise cast out.

Joh 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by Me.

Heb 4:16 Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need.

BECAUSE:

Rom 3:23 For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;

1John 1:8 If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.

SECOND STEP: Repent with true remorse!

Admit that you are lost without Christ; That your sins have seperated you from God; You are nothing without Him and recognize your desperate need for Him . Voluntarily decide to come to Him for the salvation of your soul and forgive-ness of your sins.

This means that you are done with all that is evil; unbelief; Sin and evil habits that degrade and destroy body and soul. Your body is now the temple of God 's Holy Spirit.

Mat 4:17 From that time Jesus began to preach, and to say, Repent: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.

Mar 1:15 And saying, The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand: repent ye, and believe the gospel.

Luk 5:32 I [Jesus] came not to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance.

(Repentance means you stop sinning now. Turn your back on sin and then reshape your life. You turn therefore to God .) **Psa 38:18** For I will declare mine iniquity; **I will be sorry for my sin.**

Pro 28:13 He that covereth his sins shall not prosper: but whoso confesseth and forsaketh *them* shall have mercy.

1John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us *our* sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

1John 1:7 But if we walk in the light, as He is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, **and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanseth us from all sin.**

The Rebirth:

Joh 3:3 Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.

Joh 3:5 Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be

born of water [Greek—Hudatos] and *of* the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.

Act 8:12(b), they were baptized [Greek word for baptized is BAPTIZO = Immerse, submerge, plunge, dip] both men and women.

THE BAPTISM OF JESUS [HE was about 30 years old.]

Luk 3:23 And Jesus Himself began to be about thirty years of age,

Mat 3:13 Then cometh Jesus from Galilee to Jordan unto John, to be baptized of him.

Mat 3:14 But John forbad Him, saying, I have need to be baptized of Thee, and comest Thou to me?

Mat 3:16 And Jesus, when He was baptized, went up straightway out of the water: and, lo, the heavens were opened unto Him, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove, and lighting upon Him:

Mat 28:19 [Jesus said] Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost:

Act 2:38 Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost. Verse 41 (On that same day 3,000 people were baptised.)

Rom 6:3 Know ye not, that so many of us as were baptized into Jesus Christ were baptized into his death?

Rom 6:4 Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.

Tit 3:5 Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost;

THIRD STEP: BELIEVE !!!

This is very important—you must believe !!!

Joh 3:16 For God so loved the world, that He gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him [Jesus, Christ] should not perish, but have everlasting life.

Believe that Christ will not turn you away when you come to Him.

Act 16:31 And they said, Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved, and thy house.

Eph 2:8 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: *it is* the gift of God:

Joh 1:12 But as many as received Him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, *even* to them that believe on His name:

Heb 11:6 But without faith *it is* impossible to please *Him*: for he that cometh to God must believe that He is, and *that* He is a rewarder of them that diligently seek Him.

2Co 5:17 Therefore if any man *be* in Christ, *he is* a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.

PRAYER:

Merciful Heavenly Father , I come to you now and admit that I'm a hell deserving sinner. Please forgive me and wash away all my sins with the blood of Jesus Christ your son. I accept Him now as my personal Lord and Savior. Please teach me Your ways and help me to keep Your commandments. Father, I ask this in the name of Jesus and I thank you for it.
